**Subject: Non-consideration and inaction on the Petition of the Association addressed to to the Petition Committee, Rajya Sabha regarding implementation of order of Department of Public Enterprises dated 02.04.2009 for the purpose of revision of pension of absorbed BSNL pensioners since forwarded by Rajya Sabha Secretariat to Deptt of Telecommunication.**

Sir,

We would like to submit that Rajya Sabha Secretariat had forwarded a copy of our Petition dated 08.06.2012 on the issue of "Denial of benefit of merger of 78.2% of IDA with basic pension in case of revision of pension of the absorbed BSNL pensioners by Deptt of Telecommunication due to non-implementation of DPE OM No. 2(70)/08-DPE(WC)-GL-VII/09 dated 02.04.2009" to the DoT vide its No. RS.6(199)/2012-Com-II dated 13.08.2012 for "appropriate consideration and action under intimation to the representationist". A copy of the said letter from Rajya Sabha Secretariat is enclosed herewith for your kind perusal.

2. However, we regret to say that though the letter from Rajya Sabha Secretariat was sent to DoT about four months back, no action seems to have been taken to redress our grievance as detailed in our Petition vide No.

AIBSNLREA/CHQ/2012/11 dated 08.06.2012. We have not even been informed what action DoT is taking to implement the above stated Order of DPE dated 02.04.2009, in regard to absorbed BSNL pensioners, which was binding on all CPSEs.

3. Since the issue concerns the pensioners (who retired from BSNL after taking absorption) and whose pension and pension related matters are to be paid/settled by Department of Telecommunication only, we would request you to kindly take appropriate action to implement the above stated three and half years old Order of Department of Public Enterprises.
