Sub: **Inordinate delay in settlement of Appeal against the Orders in disciplinary cases in Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited – Case of Shri T K Chitroda, Retired DE, Gujarat Telecom Circle.**

Sir,

We would once again like to draw your kind attention to the above stated case presented to you vide our letter No. AIBSNLREA/CHQ/2015/24 dated 26.07.2015 wherein we had requested for your kind intervention in the matter since Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited under the administrative Control of Department of Telecommunication is not taking any action to settle a long pending Appeal Case for last over one and half years. This caused the retired Executive in not getting his due pensionary benefits.

Though, DOP&PW had sent our representation to Department of Telecommunication vide its No. DOPPW/P/2015/03086 dated 20.08.2015 to take appropriate action, surprising the case was referred to Gujarat Telecom Circle of Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited which has sent a cryptic reply stating that "... pensionary benefit in case of Shri T K Chitroda, DE retired on 31.12.2009 is pertaining to Dot Cell, O/o of CCA Ahmedabad" (Copy enclose).

3. The above clearly indicates how insensitive and careless Department of Telecommunications and Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited are about the issues involving the pensioners. **Ours was not a case to know who is to deal with pensionary benefit case of the affected retired employee but was to get his Appeal Case pending for long period with the Chief Vigilance Officer/Chairman & Managing Director of BSNL expeditiously settled.** Therefore, it is surprising how our representation on a different subject duly forwarded by DOP&PW to Department of Telecommunications landed in a subordinate office of BSNL which has nothing to do with the Appeal Case.

4. In view of the above, we once again earnestly request for your kind personal intervention to get this issue settled at the earliest and advise both Department of Telecommunications/Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited accordingly.
