**Sub: Non-settlement of revision of pension with fitment benefit by merger of 50% DA/DR with Basic Pay / Pension effectively amounting to 78.2% DA/DR in respect of two retired Executives of BSNL Corporate Office by the STP Section of Deptt. of Telecommunications – Cases of S/Shri Jagdish Narain, Retd AGM (PPO No. 6-1356/2011/PFP/1768) and Inderjit Singh, Retd DM (PPO No. 6-1351/2010/PFP/1790).**

Madam,

Department of Telecommunications, vide its No. 42-4/2012-Pen (T) dated 18.07.2016, ordered revision of pension/family pension of the BSNL pensioners/family pensioners retired before 10.06.2013 by allowing the benefit of fitment of merger of 50% DA/DR with Basic Pay/Pension effectively amounting to 78.2% DA/DR for the purpose of fitment and also instructed to complete the exercise to extend the benefit of the order to the pensioners/family pensioners by 31.12.2016. Subsequently, in a DO letter vide DO No. 7-1/2013/TA-I/17/Pt/760 dated 07.03.2017, Member (Finance), Telecom Commission while expressing his serious concern due to huge pendency of the cases in BSNL and CCA Offices wrote to CMD, BSNL to expedite the cases and fixed revised dates for completion of the entire exercise by 10.04.2017.

2. Unfortunately, we are still receiving complaints by individual pensioners that their cases are not being settled despite continuous persuasion from their side. Following two executives who retired from BSNL Corporate Office are the typical examples of such cases:-

- (a) Shri Jagdish Narain, Retd AGM (SR) of Corporate Office, whose PPO No. is 6-1356/2011/PFP/1768, was issued a revised PPO and sent to CCA, Lucknow. Since the Revised PPO had no mention of the "Pensioners Code", the CCA, Lucknow Office returned the same to ACAO (PFP) Section of Department of Telecommunications in March 2017 vide No. CCA/UP(E)/FGN PEN/01/1086 dated 28.03.2017. But no action has been taken to settle this issue. The pensioner has been apprised of this position by CCA Lucknow vide his No. CCA/UP(E)/Rgn Pen/01/2277/13125/5740 dated 18.08.2017 (copy enclosed).

(b) Shri Inderjit Singh, Retd DM (MIS) of Corporate Office, whose PPO No. is 6-1351/2010/PFP/1790, has not been issued the revised PPO by the STP Section of DOT though BSNL Corporate Office has sent his revised pension papers long before. The pensioner who is now settled at Jammu and giving calls to different concerned DOT Officers but not getting any positive response.

3. In view of the above, we now request for your kind intervention in the above cases so that these long pending cases, which should have been settled within the revised target date fixed by Member (Finance) i.e. 10.4.2017, are at least settled now.
