**Sub: Shifting of official and concessional telephone connections of BSNL and its retired employees respectively from MTNL to proposed BSNL network in Delhi and Mumbai – Request thereof.**

Sir,

As we understand that BSNL may shortly start its own landline services in Delhi and Mumbai service areas, we would like to request that at the very first opportunity all the official telephone connections in BSNL Offices/residences of the BSNL officers along the concessional telephone connections of the BSNL retirees, who are residing in Delhi and Mumbai service areas, be shifted to proposed BSNL network.

This will not only help BSNL to avoid incurring expenditure in reimbursing the telephone bills of the retirees but also help the retirees by not having to pay the bills themselves to MTNL and then wait, without result, to get the reimbursement. Otherwise also, once BSNL starts operation of its own network, there is no justification to use the telecom services from other network incurring huge expenditure.

3. We shall be extremely thankful if our above request is considered in the interest of both BSNL and its retired employees having concessional telephone connections in Delhi and Mumbai.
