Subject: Non-addressing the genuine grievance of Shri Ravindra Kumar Tripathi, Retd SDE by Rajasthan Circle regarding issue of his Presidential Order for his absorption.

Madam,

We are constraint to seek for your kind intervention in a case wherein a retired SDE is breaking his head for over one year to get his Presidential Order issued and also his pensionary benefits settled after the currency of his punishment as ordered by the Department of Telecommunication was over.

2. Shri Ravindra Kumar Tripathi, retired SDE had submitted his option letter for absorption in BSNL to Rajasthan Telecom Circle in the year 2003. But because of a vigilance case, his Presidential Order for absorption was not issued. Now that the currency of punishment period as ordered by DOT is over and the CBI court also acquitted him of some charges, he represented for his immediate absorption in BSNL. Department of Telecom, vide its No. 23-5/2015-STG.II dated 17.01.2017 advised BSNL to send recommendation for his case. BSNL Corporate Office, in turn, vide its No. BSNL/3/SR/2017 dated 09.05.2017, advised Rajasthan Telecom Circle to send his vigilance clearance. But till this day, Rajasthan Circle has not sent the clearance.

3. It is learnt that Rajasthan Telecom Circle and the Northern Telecom Region, in which the Officer, last worked are busy only in exchanging letters and the issue of vigilance clearance is unnecessarily getting delayed. NTR was expected to report Rajasthan Telecom Circle, in response to its communication, about any possible vigilance case

before retirement of the Officer from its Unit. But it has not done so. As a result, issue of VC is being delayed.

4. In view of the above, we urge you to kindly intervene in the matter so that the matter is resolved and the continuous harassment and consequent agony of the retired executive come to an end.
