Subject: **Depositing Tax deducted at Source (TDS) in Central Government Account through Bank challans quoting WRONG PAN Numbers – Cases of BSNL Corporate Office.**

Sir,

We would like to bring to your kind notice about a serious issue mostly concerning the retired employees of BSNL Corporate Office landing them in immense trouble while submitting their Income Tax Returns for the assessment year 2012-13. Since the last of submission of returns is fast approaching the matter needs to be resolved immediately.

2      The Cash Branch of BSNL Corporate Office had deducted Tax (TDS) from the amount payable to these retired employees against re-imburement of Medical Claims for outdoor treatment. However, **while depositing the amount in Government Account through Bank Challans, the Cash Branch has mostly mentioned wrong PAN Numbers of the deductees from whom the TDS amounts were actually deducted.** The Form 16A issued by Cash Branch, therefore, are incorrect in regard to the PAN Numbers. Thus, the TDS particulars being wrong, if mentioned in Income Tax Forms, there will be disputes and the concerned TAX payers will be facing harassment in order to settle the IT Returns for no fault on their part.

3      We understand that the documentation work for preparing/submitting the challans has been outsourced in BSNL Corporate Office. It is regretted that there is no check on their work and no verification of the correctness of the documentation prepared by them is being done. No one seems to be serious on the matter which concerns payment of Income Tax.

4      Considering the gravity of the matter, we would request that the Income Tax

Department may immediately be intimated the correct PAN Numbers in respect of the Deductees for whom the information are immediately available in the Cash Branch. The other mistakes, as and when detected, may also be informed without delay. The concerned retired/serving employees may also be issued corrected Form 16A immediately to enable them to file Income Tax Returns correctly.
