Sub: Non-settlement of discrepancy in the final payment of GPF to Shri Channappa M. Urologin, Retired JTO of Maharashtra Telecom Circle of BSNL by Controller of Communication Accounts, Maharashtra & Goa Circle.

Sir,

We are compelled to seek your kind personal intervention in the above case in which a pensioner Shri Channappa M. Urologin, Retired JTO who last worked in Kolhapur SSA of Maharashtra Telecom Circle of BSNL has not been paid full payment of his GPF by Controller of Communication Accounts, Maharashtra & Goa Circle. Before his transfer to Maharashtra Telecom Circle from which he retired, Shri Urologin, Retd JTO was working in Western Telecom Project, Mumbai. **The GPF amount deducted from his salary, while working in Western Telecom Project Circle, along with accrued interest has not been paid to him while making final payment of GPF.**


2. In this case Shri Channappa M. Urologin, Retd JTO had made so may representations, but still the issue is not resolved. Incidentally, it is to be mentioned that Shri Channappa M. Urologin, Retd JTO had a GPF A/C No. WTP-25700 when he worked in Western Telecom Project Circle, Mumbai. However, in Maharashtra Telecom Circle from which he retired, his GPF A/C No. was MH Circle-800903.

3. **We regret to state that the Controller of Communication Accounts, Maharashtra & Goa, instead of resolving the issue at its level, has recently advised the pensioner concerned to submit all the ledgers signed by the then A.O. from 1.4.1998 onward to till the date of his retirement. This clearly indicates the level of insensitiveness of the CCA, Maharashtra & Goa Circle towards the pensioners.**

4. In view of the above, we request you to kindly intervene in the matter and advise Controller of Communication Accounts, Maharashtra & Goa Circle to make payment of the balance of the GPF amount along with interest to the concerned pensioner Shri Channappa M. Urologin, Retd JTO without further delay.
