
2. BSNL issued a letter to all its Circles vide No.412-03/2019-Part I dated 16.07.2019 indicating therein that BSNL is about to process the case for extending the consequential benefits, as ordered by the Supreme Court, listing 162 promotion orders issued by BSNL.

3. After nearly 20 months, BSNL vide its letter No.BSNLCO-PETS/12(11)/2/2021-Pers1 dated 09.03.2021 communicated the decisions taken in the review DPC of the first regular DPC held by BSNL in the year 2009 (promotion orders issued vide Order No. 412-25/2009-Pers. I dated 14.10.2009 for 277 executives) and thus initiating revised pay fixation, pension revision etc of those promoted notionally w.e.f. 14.10.2009 as per the revised seniority list. But there is no indication of such review DPC in respect of all the other promotion orders issued and listed in its letter dated 16.07.2019. Most of the executives who are to be benefitted by the revised seniority have already retired either on superannuation or under VRS. Further delay in implementing the judgement of Supreme Court of India in extending the consequential benefits to these executives and pensioners will amount to denial of justice.

4. We therefore request you to kindly bestow your personal attention to this important issue and cause review DPCs in respect of all the other promotion orders issued by BSNL so

as to implement the said Supreme Court judgement and to extend all the consequential benefits without further delay.
