Sub: Request for settlement of superannuation pension and release of other pensionary benefits– Case of Shri Dinesh Chandra Gupta, Retd SDE (HRMS No 198218065) relieved from UP(East) Telecom Circle to join Bihar Telecom Circle.

Sir,

We would like to seek your kind personal intervention in resolving the above issue in which the above-named retired Executive could not immediately join his new Circle of posting after being relieved by UP (East) Telecom Circle of 27.09.2019 due to his own chronic ailment of Cirrhosis of liver and other complications and also because of the fact that he was yet come out of the shock of losing three members of the family one after the other only a couple of years back which caused him bearing additional responsibility in the family. Subsequently, due to Covid-19 pandemic, all train and bus services were ordered to be suspended and he could not travel to join Bihar Telecom Circle.


2. Unfortunately, his inter-Circle transfer Order was issued, vide BSNL Corporate Office No. 1-7/2019-Pers.II/1 dated 23.09.2019, when he had only nine months service left for his superannuation. Hoping that his request to cancel the transfer Order issued just on the eve of his superannuation would be acceded to, he went on representing to consider his prayer to cancel the said transfer Order and allow him to retire from UP (East) Circle, since he was to settle in UP State after his retirement. Unfortunately, he did not receive any response to his numerous representations for cancellation of his transfer Order. Being frustrated of the situation and finding no other alternative, he finally decided to join Bihar Telecom Circle. But by that time all transport systems were suspended due to Covid-19 pandemic and lockdown.

3. Bihar Telecom Circle, finally as ordered by BSNL Corporate Office, issued Orders vide its No. ST/10-1/TES Grp 'B'/Retirement/2015/206 dated 30.05.2020, for his provisional retirement w.e.f. A/N of 31.05.2020 and also withholding his DCRG, CVP etc. Now, his regular pension and other pensionary benefits being withheld, he is facing acute financial crisis and the entire family is suffering.

4. In view of the above, we again earnestly request you to kindly intervene in the matter with humanitarian consideration so that the above-named affected pensioner starts receiving his regular superannuation pension and other pensionary benefits are also paid to him at the earliest.
