
Madam,

We would like to draw your kind attention that the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the above case which was delivered on 14/12/2017 is yet to be implemented fully. In the above case, BSNL had submitted the Seniority Lists before the Hon'ble Supreme Court. It is also a fact that DOT had earlier issued revised seniority Lists No. I to XVII for the JTOs who qualified in the TES Group B qualifying examinations held earlier in terms of Para 206 of P&T Manual Volume IV. BSNL also followed it up by issuing further seniority Lists. But, BSNL is yet to extend the consequential benefits as ordered by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in its judgment delivered on 14/12/2017, though long seven months have passed since the judgment was pronounced.

2. We would, therefore, request you for early issue of Orders to extend the consequential benefits upon revision of the seniority lists of the JTOs qualified in TES Group B Qualifying Examinations and thus comply with the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the above stated Civil Appeal.
