Sub: Revalidation of BSNL Medical card & payment of medical cash allowance with/without voucher facility to retired employees - Request for issue of clarification - reg

2. Our letter No.AIBSNLREA/CHQ/2021/33 dated 9th July 2021

Sir,

This is in continuation of our letter cited under reference 2 above, wherein we had requested to get the grievance examined and cause withdrawal of the letter under reference 1 above. Alternatively, we had requested that the letter may be modified so as to necessitate submission of option **only by those who want to change from one scheme to other and submission of details/documents only by those for whom there have been any change/changes**, so that the unnecessary harassment of the entire retired employees of BSNL is stopped.


2. We find that Chennai Telephones, Tamilnadu have issued orders [copy enclosed] requiring fresh option to be submitted **only by those whose bank account number and IFSC have changed due to merger of banks and those who want to change the option**. Gujarat and Kerala Circles are also reported to have issued a similarly worded orders. As all these orders have been issued with reference to BSNL letter cited under Reference 1 above and carry similar text, it is believed that they have issued orders with the concurrence of Corporate Office. Non-issue of similar order by other Circles have created confusion and concern among the pensioners of those circles.

3. We therefore request you to kindly cause immediate issue of clarification that option is required to be submitted **only by those who want to change from one scheme to other and submission of details/documents only by those for whom there have been any**

change/changes as the last date mentioned in BSNL letter referred to above, 10.08.2021, is fast approaching.
