Sub: Revision of Seniority list of TES Group B Officers in compliance of Hon'ble Supreme Court judgments to extend the consequential benefits – discriminatory decision by BSNL against the BSNL Executives promoted to DE(T)/DGM(T) prior to 2001.

Madam,

We have represented to you on the above issue vide our No. AIBSNLREA/CHQ/2018/44 dated 01.09.2018 requesting your kind intervention and also to advise BSNL and others to implement the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court regarding revision of seniority of the TES Group B Officers and extension of consequential benefits in their letter and spirits and in full and also to ensure that no discrimination is made against those BSNL executives who were promoted to DE(T)/DGM(T) prior to 2001.

2. We now submit with regret that there had been inadvertent typographical errors at the end of para 3 and 4 of the said representation wherein the last word in both the paras were wrongly typed as "1981" in place of "2001". The corrected para 3 and 4 are as follows:-

3. Thus, BSNL's above unilateral decision for revision of promotion to the DE(T)/DGM(T) issued to the BSNL Executives only after 2001 onwards is in gross violation of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and also a blatant discriminatory one against those absorbed BSNL Executives who were promoted prior to 2001.

4. In view of the above, we seek your kind intervention in this matter and urge you to kindly advise BSNL and other concerned to implement the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in

their letter and spirits and in full and also to ensure that no discrimination is made against those BSNL executives who were promoted to DE(T)/DGM(T) prior to 2001.
