Sub: Denial of the benefit of notional promotion and consequential pensionary benefits in terms of DOP&T OM No. 22011/3/2013-Estt. (D) dated 25.01.2016 by not implementing the DOT's promotion Order No. 2/7/08/STG.II dated 21.10.1998 – Case of Shri Shankar Singh Yadav, Retd JTO (HRMS 197605567), BSNL, Maharashtra Telecom Circle.

Sir,

We had been taking up the above case in which the pensioner Shri Shankar Singh Yadav Retd JTO, once working in Maharashtra Telecom Circle and permanently absorbed in BSNL after his acquittal of charges vide DoT No. 27-1/MHTC/G.M.T.NP/172/2014-15 dated 29/05/2015 and regularization of his period of suspension by DOT vide its No. 9-86/1996-Vig.I dated 4/9/2015, has not yet been given his "notional promotion" as admissible under the DOP&T OM No. 22011/3/2013-Estt. (D) dated 25.01.2016. Incidentally, earlier to his suspension order he was even ordered to be promoted by DOT vide No. 2/7/08/STG.II dated 21.10.1998 which however could be not implemented due to the pending charges.


2. Since the representations of the pensioner Shri Shankar Singh Yadav, Retd JTO, after his acquittal, failed to evoke any response, we took up the matter and one of our representations, vide our No. AIBSNLREA/CHQ/2019/09 dated 20.03.2019, requesting to allow him the benefit of "notional promotion" and other consequential pensionary benefits as stipulated in DOP&T OM No. 22011/3/2013-Estt. (D) dated 25.01.2016, was duly forwarded to you by Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare vide the above cited reference Number "to take appropriate necessary action in the matter as per extant rules". Unfortunately, so far neither the issue has been settled nor any progress made in the case has been intimated.

3. In view of the above, we request you for early settlement of the case and also to intimate the progress made to render justice to Shri Shankar Singh Yadav, Retd JTO by allowing him the

benefit of "notional promotion" and other consequential pensionary benefits as stipulated in DOP&T OM No. 22011/3/2013-Estt. (D) dated 25.01.2016.
