Sub: Urging kind intervention to rescind the discriminatory Order issued by the BSNL Management to deny reimbursement of Medical Claims of the BSNL IDA pensioners but allowing the Serving employees alone to receive their claims under the same BSNL Medical Reimbursement Scheme.

Sir,

We are constrained to seek your kind personal intervention to render justice to the aged and hapless BSNL IDA pensioners, since **BSNL Management has issued a discriminatory Order to its Circles asking them to get ready to make payment of pending medical claims only of the serving employees along with their June, 2020 salary, but denying reimbursement of medical claims under the same BSNLMRS to the BSNL IDA pensioners whose claims for reimbursement are pending with BSNL for over a year.** We fail to understand how BSNL Management can deny reimbursement to its retired employees but allow payment only to the serving employees under the same BSNL Medical Reimbursement Scheme. This is another instance of BSNL Management's step motherly and biased attitude against the BSNL IDA pensioners.

2. Only recently, we brought to the notice of Secretary (Telecom) and others seeking their intervention vide our letters No. AIBSNLREA/CHQ/2020/47 dated 18.06.2020 and No. AIBSNLREA/CHQ/2020/51 dated 29.06.2020 in the matter of non-reimbursement of long pending medical claims of the BSNL IDA pensioners and also about another **instruction issued by BSNL Management to all its Circles, vide its No. BSNL/ERP/FICO/2018-19 dated 25.07.2019, not to post all claims of the retired officials in the SAP system and accordingly to block the medical liability creation of retired officials in SAP from 25th July 2019 to October 2019.**

3. Unfortunately, we are yet to receive any response to our above requests and BSNL is still continuing with its discriminatory action against the BSNL IDA pensioners even on a sensitive issue like Medicare facilities.

4. We, therefore, once again urge you to kindly intervene in the matter so that no discrimination is meted out to the BSNL IDA pensioners by BSNL Management on the issue of reimbursement of long pending medical claims.
