**Sub: Non-payment of Group Savings Linked Insurance Scheme (GSLI) amount to the BSNL Employees retired under BSNL VRS- 2019 by LIC of India.**

Sir,

We regret to bring it to your kind notice that most of the BSNL VRS-2019 retirees, even after seven long months of their retirement, have not been paid their GSLI (Group Savings Linked Insurance Scheme) amount by Life Insurance Corporation of India which they are supposed to receive immediately on their retirement. According to the terms and conditions of the Scheme, "the membership of the scheme in respect of a member shall terminate upon the Member ceasing to be in the service of the Employer, either on superannuation or voluntary retirement" and "Upon termination of the Membership, the Life assurance benefit of the member shall cease forthwith and the amount at his credit in the Running Account as determined in Rule 8(ii) shall become payable". Though the above issue was brought to the notice of the authorities concerned in BSNL Corporate Office, no action seems to have been taken to resolve the matter.

2.1 Unfortunately, some of the claims which were forwarded to Life Insurance Corporation of India for payment, still remain unsettled. More so, none of the retirees who retired from Delhi Offices of BSNL received their payment.

2.2 Moreover, many Circles are yet to forward some cases to the LIC for payment. This includes BSNL Corporate Office which is still to forward nearly 70 cases to LIC of India for payment of the amount to the concerned retirees.

3.0 In view of the above, BSNL may kindly be advised to instruct its Circle to immediately forward all the pending cases to the LIC of India for payment. Similarly, LIC should be requested to make early payment of all the claims which are pending with them.

4. We shall be extremely thankful if you kindly intervene in the matter, so that the issue gets resolved at the earliest.
