Sir,

We are once again constrained to seek your kind intervention in the above issues since Controller of Communication Accounts, Karnataka Circle has taken no action on our earlier representation addressed to you vide our No. AIBSNLREA/CHQ/2020/32 dated 12.05.2020 even though the Pension Section of Department of Telecommunications, vide its No. 34-13/2020-Pen(T) dated 26.05.2020 [Copy enclosed], had forwarded our said representation to the CCA, Karnataka Circle advising him to examine the same for necessary action under intimation to the Pension Branch.

2. It is surprising that ***the case for granting final superannuation pension to Shri S B Mohare, Retd Accounts Officer, Gulbarga TD is still remained unresolved and again he has not even been paid his provisional pension since March, 2020 for the reasons best known to CCA, Karnataka only.***

3. ***It is a matter of great regret that earlier the Dy CCA, Karnataka via e-mail on 13.05.2020 had informed this Association that the pension for March and April 2020 was released on 06.05.2020. But the Union Bank of India, the Pension Disbursing Bank in this case, seems to have received no instruction so far. As a result, the pensioner has not received his provisional pension continuously for last four months.***

4. Considering the financial constraints and mental agony of this hapless pensioner, who also has to take care of his 95-year old ailing father, we earnestly request you to kindly cause immediate final settlement of his cases.
