Sub: Non-refund of GPF contributions and the interests accrued thereon for the period of November 1986 to September 1990 - Case of Shri V Velappan, Retd DGM, BSNL, Tamilnadu Telecom Circle.

Sir,

We regret to inform you that our representation on the above issue, vide our letter No. AIBSNLREA/CHQ/2019/14 dated 9.5.2019, which was duly acknowledged by your Office vide above referred Correspondence No. dated 04.06.2019 and our subsequent representations on the same matter have failed to get any response from Department of Telecommunications and the hard earned money in the form of GPF deducted from the salary and deposited with DOT of the above hapless pensioner, while he was in service, has not been refunded so far.

2. On his promotion as AE, the affected pensioner Shri V Velappan was transferred from DMT, Coimbatore to MTNL Mumbai and he served in his new place of posting from November 1986 till May 1993. Since, as per the then existing Orders of DOT, his GPF Account was to be maintained by DMT, Coimbatore, MTNL Mumbai regularly sent the GPF contributions made by him to DMT, Coimbatore from October 1986 to September 1990. His subsequent GPF contributions were, however, maintained by MTNL, Mumbai as per the revised Orders issued by Department of Telecommunications. During this period, he was an employee of Department of Telecommunications. It is most unfortunate that even after 6 years of his retirement from service, his money in the form of GPF has not been refunded to him.

3. In view of the above, we request you to kindly intervene in the matter so that the above-named pensioner gets back his GPF contributions with accrued interest for the period of November 1986 to September 1990, while serving in DOT, without further delay.
