**Sub: Non-implementation of DOP&PW OM No 41/21/2000-P&PW(D) dated 12.08.2015 for issue of Identity Cards in a revised format linking Aadhar numbers to the absorbed BSNL IDA pensioners drawing pension from Government under CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972**

Sir,

We would like to draw your kind personal attention to our earlier representations vide No. AIBSNLREA/CHQ/2016/19 dated 18.05.2016 and No AIBSNLREA/CHQ/2016/51 dated 22.09.2016 on the above subject wherein we pointed out that Department of Telecommunication is yet to implement the above stated OM of DOP&PW and get the Identity Cards in the revised format linking Aadhar number issued to the absorbed BSNL Pensioners.

2. We had also brought to your notice that BSNL, in a communication to DOT, has stated that it cannot issue identity cards in the prescribed format on behalf of the Ministry since the format has a space to indicate the name of the issuing Ministry of Government of India. We had also enclosed a copy of the said communication from BSNL with our representation dated 22.9.2016 addressed to you for your kind consideration. We also pointed out that even now BSNL issues Identity Cards to the absorbed BSNL pensioners, but without linking the Aadhar number. It is really surprising that BSNL now finds difficulties in issuing the Identity Cards in the format as prescribed by DOP&PW. We are also unable to appreciate that Department of Telecommunications, being the administrative Ministry of BSNL, is taking no action to comply with above quoted OM dated 12.08.2015 issued by DOP&PW.

3. In view of the above, we once again request you to kindly intervene in the matter and get your above quoted Office Memorandum dated 12.08.2015 implemented at the earliest in respect of the absorbed BSNL IDA pensioners who are drawing pension from Government under CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972.
