Sub: Inordinate delay in settling the Appeal to review the punishment Order issued by DOT in view of the petitioner being acquitted by the court charged under same charges –Case of Shri S S Unhale, Retd Sr SDE, Buldhana, Maharashtra Telecom Circle.

Madam,

We are constraint to draw your kind attention to a case in which a pensioner continues to be deprived of justice even though a Court acquitted him of the same charges filed by CBI on which Department of Telecommunication had earlier issued him a punishment Order.

2. Shri S S Unhale, Retd Sr SDE, Buldhana, Maharashtra Telecom Circle was punished by DOT vide its No. 8-49/98-Vig.I dated 19.03.2008 by ordering reduction of his pay by one stage. Meanwhile CBI also filed a court case against him and few other officials on the same charges. Finally, the Court passed an Order on 30.08.2013 acquitting him of all the charges and the CBI also decided not to move higher court with an appeal. Following this, Shri S S Unhale made an appeal to exonerate him of the same charges which were earlier made by the Department against him. This appeal is now pending in DOT since long and the petitioner who has retired on superannuation on 30.11.2011 continues to suffer since his pay and pension is not being revised.

3. In view of the above, we request you to kindly intervene in the matter so that his appeal is disposed off early with a positive note and the agony and sufferings of a pensioner comes to an end.
