



## Editorial

### CONFUSION OR AN INVITATION TO CHAOS?

In our last editorial, we had discussed about the developments on pay revision of the BSNL executives following acceptance of 3<sup>rd</sup> PRC recommendations on the pay scales and other allowances of the CPSE Executives by the Government. We had dispassionately discussed the issue, since pension revision of BSNL retirees solely depends on the revision of pay scales of the serving employees in BSNL. We find that the proposal for revision of pay scales with 15% fitment benefit for BSNL Executives is progressing in a positive direction which has already crossed a few levels of decision making. So far, it did not meet with any hurdle. However, there are people who have other ideas and they enact some scenes to keep their flocks together. Instead of channelizing their resources for smooth passage of the proposal, some are seen to go for failed cease work call and some others try to illuminate the roads of Delhi with lit candles. They should instead keep their energies reserved and use it only when it demands.

We are, now, waiting for the day when the proposal would reach DoT's court to get its approval. At that stage, the issue of orders for pension revision with same fitment benefit as being allowed to the serving executives will acquire momentum. But will

the pension revision of the retired BSNL Executives be allowed to move separately or any attempt would be made to tag it with the pension revision of non-executive pensioners even though the wage negotiation for the serving non-executive employees has not even started? Though such an attempt to obstruct the pension revision of the executives will neither be logical nor will it stand the law of the land as laid down by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. True, on the last occasion the pension revision of both the executives and non-executives was processed simultaneously. But that was a different situation when the Department was indecisive on the question of allowing revised fitment benefit by merger of 78.2% IDA in the revised pay scales of the Executives who were already allowed revised pay scales with fitment benefit by merger of 68.8% IDA as per the orders available on the day. Only after the non-executive Unions agreed to shelve the revised fitment benefit by merger of 78.2% IDA for the future and accepted pay scale revision for non-executives only with fitment benefit by merger 68.8% IDA, as was given to the Executives, the path for pension revision of both executives and non-executive pensioners became clear and

both the cases were processed in a single proposal.

Now the situation is totally different. There is no confusion regarding the fitment benefits to be allowed as was the case on last occasion. The pay scale revision of executives will surely be issued first without waiting for the outcome of wage negotiation of the non-executives which may take more time. With the pay scale revision of the executives, pension revision of the retired executives automatically becomes due as per the law of the land. There is no reason to delay it pending wage revision of non-executive employees.

When we are clear about our aims and objectives., some others are busy in dragging the pension revision of BSNL pensioners into a big confusion. They are

found to be creating confusion by renewing their demand for pension revision for BSNL IDA pensioners with fitment benefit recommended by 7<sup>th</sup> CPC– though the law of the land as laid down the Hon’ble Supreme Court does not permit this. We have discussed such issues in the past on a number of occasions and even put up many articles in this very website. In our last editorial also, we straightened the position on the very principle for pension revision. Hope they do not invite the similar situation which they created during last pension revision of BSNL retirees by demanding pension revision on presumptive CDA pay and thereby inviting a danger for the BSNL pensioners to lose heavily as per their proposal. Anyhow, the constant vigil, strong move and stiff opposition by AIBSNLREA could prevent the damage. ■

### **INCREASE IN IDA**

According to calculations based on All India Consumer Price Index for Industrial Workers, IDA is to increase w.e.f. 1.10.2017 by 5.3% for CPSEs where last pay revision was implemented w.e.f. 1.1.2007 and by 8.9% where last pay revision was implemented w.e.f. 1.1.1997.

He also briefed about the DPE Office Memorandum dated 3/8/2017 notifying the revised pay scales for the CPSEs Executives as per 3<sup>rd</sup> PRC recommendations. Affordability conditions in the OM for implementation of the revised pay scales was also discussed. The proposal for pay revision of BSNL executives will be put up before the BSNL Board after clearance by the management Committee of BSNL. Finally Department of Telecommunications shall issue the administrative order. It was categorically mentioned that without pay revision of the serving BSNL employees, the pension/family revision of the absorbed BSNL pensioners/family pensioners cannot take place in view the Supreme Court decision that there shall be no difference in pension between past and future pensioners which has become the law of the land. GS CHQ is strictly keeping vigil on this key issue. Finally he appealed to all members and well-wishers to come forward and pay liberal contribution on receiving the pension revision arrears and seeking legal remedy to get the denied benefits in the wider interest of BSNL pensioners.

14 new life members joined the Nagpur Branch of the Association taking the total membership to 348 as on day of meeting.
