Grievance Description

In the attached representation, personal attention of Principal General Manager (Pers), BSNL CO has been drawn to the earlier letter No. AIBSNLREA/CHQ/2020/139 dated 11.01.2020 by the Association requesting to issue the final superannuation order to Shri S V Rojed, Retd SDE (HR No. 197503181) of QAI Circle, who was earlier permitted to retire provisionally from service on 31.03.2012 vide BSNL C.O. F.No 17-10/2012-Pers.II dated 30.03.2012. The Association has further stated that Quality Assurance Inspection Circle, vide its letter No. CGM(QAI)/SG-2904/CPGRMS/2020-2021 dated 11.01.2021, has informed that the AGM (Pers.II-Staff), BSNL C.O., under his letter No. BSNLCO-PRII/22(10)/2020-PERS-II dated 25.08.2020, had requested CGMT, QA Inspection Circle to provide details regarding provisional pension retirement Orders in respect of Shri S V Rojed, Ex-SDE. The Circle, accordingly, had also forwarded the copy of the same vide its No. CGM(QA I)/SG-2121/SDE/EPP/2012/Pt dated 08.09.2020 to Principal General Manager (Pers), BSNL Corporate Office. But the Personnel Branch is yet to issue the final superannuation Order in respect of Shri S V Rojed, Retd SDE. As a result, the pensioner is continuously being denied of his final superannuation pension including pensionary benefits like DCRG, Commuted Value of Pension and other service benefits. AIBSNLREA has, therefore, again requested to cause issue of final superannuation Order to Shri S V Rojed, Retd SDE, QA Circle.

ORDER

Sub: Retirement on Superannuation in respect of Executive belonging to SDE (T) Cadre-regarding.

Sh. Rojed Shankarappa V. SDE (T), HRMS No. 197503181, QA Circle, is permitted to retire from BSNL services on attaining the age of superannuation w.e.f. 31.03.2012 A/N.

2. He was permitted to retire on superannuation provisionally on 31.03.2012 A/N vide BSNL CO order No. 17-10/2012-Pers II. Dated 30.03.2012 as vigilance status of the executive was withheld.
3. Now vigilance clearance in respect of the above executive has been GRANTED by vigilance branch, CO BSNL vide their letter No. 22-11/2019/VC2/Retirement Settlement Dated: 18.02.2021 for release of final retirement benefits and final retirement order with the remarks that:

Note:- A prosecution was sanctioned vide file no. No.262-38/07-VM-V dated 18/12/2007 dated 18.12.2007 and Acquitted vide judgment no. CC No.11/2013 dated 25.10.2018. "Shri Rojed Shankarappa, ENTERED INTO A CRIMINAL CONSPIRACY WITH SRI MALLINATH INDUR IN PROCESSING FRAUDULENT BILLS CAUSING A LOSS OF Rs.31,27,514/= TO BSNL. CBI Informed that Criminal Appeal filed against the acquittal order in Hon'ble High Court of Karnataka"


And also as per record available CBI section of CVO office a, CBI case no. RC-19(A)/2005-BLR dated 31.08.2005 was registered and details as below:-

- (i) CBI, ACB, Bangalore had recommended Prosecution against Shri S V Rojed, the then SDE, BSNL, Gulbarga, Karnataka.
- (ii) The Prosecution Sanction order was issued against Shri S V Rojed by DIR (HR), BSNL vide order no. 262-38/07-VM-V dated 18.01.2007.
- (iii) Shri. S.V. Rojed has been acquitted in the case vide Hon'ble III Addl. District & Session Judge (Special Judge for Lokayukta & CBI Cases), Dharwad Judgment dated 25.10.2018.

Further, CBI vide its letter no. C5/RC 19/05CBI/ACB/BLR/2021/2014 dated 21.01.2021 has intimated that CBI has filed the appeal no. 100091/2019 on 25.02.2019 against the aforesaid judgment dated 25.10.2018 before Hon'ble High court of Karnataka, Dharwad and same is admitted by the Hon'ble High Court and pending for final disposal.

4. Regarding release of retirement benefits during pendency of criminal appeal in respect of BSNL absorbed / recruited employees, Estt. Branch has issued guidelines vide their letter no.48-7/2018-Pen (B) dated 30.12.2019. Such order may, however, be subject to the outcome of any Appeal/revision petition filed against the acquittal and the position may be reviewed by the department on the outcome of the Appeal/ Revision Petition. Accordingly, an undertaking may be obtained from the executive before releasing the retirement benefits.
5. As the Vigilance clearance has been granted in respect of Shri ROJED SHANKARAPPA V (Retired SDE), his retirement benefits and pension may be regulated in view of para 3 & 4 above and relevant rules on the subject.
6. Government / BSNL dues, if any, outstanding against the executive may be recovered under intimation to this office.

This issues with the approval of the competent authority.
