Sub: Abnormal delay in extending the consequential benefits to the JTOs qualified in TES Group 'B' qualifying examinations on their revision of seniority in TES Group B following Supreme Court judgment delivered on 14.12.2017- Denial of benefits to the pensioners absorbed as Executives of Telecom stream in BSNL

Madam,

We are constrained to state with deep regret that BSNL is deliberately delaying implementation of the Supreme Court judgment delivered on 14.12.2017 to allow consequential benefits to the TES Group B Officers based on their revised seniority Lists as were submitted by BSNL before it and also approved by the Court and thus denying the due benefits to the said TES Group B Officers, whose seniority stands revised, which include many absorbed BSNL pensioners.



Now BSNL has issued another seniority list, vide its Office letter No. as referred to above, just to include some missing particulars in respect of few of them without making any change in the seniority and in the process has thus wasted two valuable years for the concerned pensioners who are supposed to get the consequential benefits as ordered by the Supreme Court in its judgment dated 14.12.2017. Unfortunately, BSNL has, so far, not taken any concrete action to implement the said Supreme Court judgment in its letter and spirit to allow the consequential benefits to all concerned.

3. In view of the above, we seek your kind intervention in this matter and urge you to kindly advise BSNL and the Personnel Branch of DOT to implement the judgment of the Hon'ble

Supreme Court in their letter and spirits and to ensure that no discrimination is made against the BSNL executives irrespective of whether they were promoted to DE(T)/DGM(T) by DOT or BSNL.
