Sub: Inordinate delay in finalization of a disciplinary case pending against Shri Budheswar Mistry, Retired DE, Hazaribagh, BSNL Jharkhand Circle.

Sir,

We express our profuse gratitude to you for forwarding our representation dated 15.03.2015 on the above issue to Shri Rakesh Garg, I.A.S., Secretary, Department of Telecommunication vide your DO No. Secy/AR&PG/PG/2015/5856 dated 23.03.2015 emphasizing the need for early finalization of the case.

2. But we regret to inform you that Department of Telecommunication has failed to realize the gravity of the situation and take steps to finalize the case. In the process, a hapless elder, retired from service in 2006, is still being denied his pensionary benefits and other dues. It is certainly a matter of concern that the Jharkhand Telecom Circle had sent the I.O. report of the case as back as in 2010, but still Department of Telecommunication is sitting over the case. We apprehend that the concerned Officers/Officials in Department of Telecommunication have become so insensitive in this case, that an elder is being penalized for no fault on his part for years.

This is an irony that the Prime Minister of India sends a message on 31st March 2015 to all the elders of the country that "My Government is thus committed to ensuring that your golden years are spent happily, peacefully and meaningfully", but a Department under the Government fails to take cognizance of his genuine concerns for the elders. It is really a matter of shame that when the Prime Minister of the country is so concerned about the welfare of the elders, the

officials/officers of Vigilance Wing of Department of Telecommunications are proving themselves as most insensitive and casual in their approach.

4. In the above background, we again appeal to you to kindly intervene in the matter and get the above issue finalized at the earliest.
