Sub: Undue delay in processing transfer of pension requests from BSNL pensioners now residing in Gujarat State, by CCA Maharashtra & Goa

Madam,

This is w.r.t to our letter cited under Ref.1 above, wherein we had brought to your kind notice that many requests for transfer of pension from CCA Maharashtra & Goa to CCA Gujarat were remaining unprocessed for a long time, causing inconvenience to the pensioners. Three such cases were tabulated therein as detailed below:

2. CCA Maharashtra & Goa vide his email cited under Ref.2 above had informed us that “the matter has been resolved. It is further intimated that the Pension Transfer Request Form in respect of Shri R. N. Thakkar and Shri S. K. Desai has been generated by this office (copy attached). In the case of Shri A. S. Suthar, the Pension Transfer Request Form has been generated by CCA Gujarat.” Immediately thereafter, the concerned pensioners duly submitted the signed Transfer Request Forms generated by CCA Maharashtra & Goa and CCA Gujarat, as applicable.

3. As the matter still remained unresolved, we submitted a reminder email to CCA Maharashtra & Goa on 15.03.2026, requesting early transfer of the pension to CCA Gujarat. However, the pension has not been transferred till date, causing continued anxiety and concern to the affected pensioners.

4. We therefore request you to kindly issue necessary directions to CCA Maharashtra & Goa to ensure that the pension of these three pensioners is transferred to CCA Gujarat without any further delay.
