Sir,

We represent former BSNL Executives who had played important roles in various responsibilities in keeping the organisation run smoothly and efficiently. We have Branches across the country, which periodically hold meetings to deliberate on the issues pertaining to the pensioners in common and BSNL pensioners in particular. While some Circles/Units/BAs willingly provide space for holding such meetings, even in the Conference Halls, most of the other units are reluctant to provide any space. It is no secret that after implementation of BSNL VRS 2019 almost all BSNL buildings have a number of unused rooms gathering dust.
