Subject: Extension of concessional broadband facility to the retired BSNL employees residing in MTNL Service areas

Sir,

In continuation to our discussion with you on the above issue in the meeting that was granted to us on 20.12.2016 wherein we were advised to submit a comprehensive proposal, we now submit as under:-

- (1) BSNL, vide its No. 2-06/2005-PHA(Pt) dated 27.06.2012 and No. 2-06/2005-PHA(Pt) dated 22.03.2013, allowed concessional broadband facility to the retired BSNL employees residing only in the areas served by BSNL [vide Annexure-I & II].
- (2) BSNL has also allowed "monetary equivalent of the concession of Rs. 150/- per month" for Broadband connection to its employees residing in MTNL areas vide its No. 2-06/2005-PHA dated 03.06.2011 [vide Annexure-III].
- (3) Unfortunately, the retired BSNL employees alone who are residing in MTNL areas have been left out to receive even the monetary equivalent of the concession of Rs. 150/- per month for broadband connection.
- (4) The number of retired BSNL employees who are residing in MTNL areas and to be granted the benefit is not huge, since most of them reside in Ghaziabad, Gurugram, Noida, Panipat, Sonapat and other adjoining areas served by BSNL. Their numbers could easily be ascertained from Delhi based BSNL Units like BSNL Corporate Office, NTR, NTP etc which now reimburse the telephone bills for concessional residential landline connections.

2. In view of the above submissions, we earnestly request you to kindly get the issue examined so that the retired BSNL employees residing in MTNL areas are also extended the same "monetary

equivalent of the concession of Rs. 150/- per month” for broadband connections as now being allowed to the serving BSNL employees in MTNL areas to end the present discrimination and render justice.
