**Sub: Request for kind intervention in the matter of denial of benefit of fixation of pension by taking into account the extra increment granted on post-based promotion under BSNL Executive Promotion Policy - Cases of the BSNL Executives who retired between July 2017 and April 2018.**

Hon'ble Sir,

We now find no alternative but to encroach upon your valuable time to seek early redressal of a very grievance of a section of the retired BSNL Executives, who retired between July 2017 and April 2018 but surprisingly denied the benefit of fixation of pension by taking into account the extra increment granted on their post-based promotion under BSNL Executive Promotion Policy. But the other Executives who retired earlier to July 2017 and subsequent to April 2018 under the same Promotion Policy were allowed the benefit. Thus, the benefit stands denied only to those who retired in between. This is a case of shear discrimination to a section of the BSNL Executives who retired between July 2017 and April 2018, since other Executives who retired earlier or later to them are granted the benefit- though all of them are covered under the same Promotion Policy and are entitled to get the same benefit.


2. Earlier, after our series of representations, we had last represented to Secretary (Telecom), vide our letter No. AIBSNLREA/CHQ/2019/06 dated 11.03.2019, with copy endorsed to Secretary (Pension). But to our dismay, we find that this grievance has not been resolved till date. This is a case which Department of Telecommunication, as the administrative Department of BSNL, has to settle. But the total silence and inaction on the part of Department of Telecommunication has completely shocked the affected pensioners.
