Sub: **Grievances of the absorbed BSNL IDA pensioners- Resolution adopted in the All India Conference of AIBSNLREA held at Varanasi on 24th and 25th March, 2026 seeking intervention of Hon'ble Prime Minister of India in "Implementation of Supreme Court judgment on TES Group B seniority (Lists 1-17)."**

Hon'ble Sir,

In the All India Conference of this Association convened at Varanasi on 24th and 25th March 2026, which witnessed participation by a substantial number of delegates from across the country, the delegates voiced acute dissatisfaction and concern over the continued non-redressal of pensioners' grievances, particularly those affecting BSNL IDA pensioners. The Conference also recorded its serious disquiet over the consistent disregard by the Department of Telecommunications and BSNL of the binding instructions issued by the Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare on several matters.

2. In view of the above, the Conference unanimously resolved to approach the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India for timely intervention, as it was felt that the concerned Ministries and Departments have, in numerous cases, been disposing of grievances with routine and unrelated replies instead of addressing the substantive issues involved. The Conference adopted a total of 13 Resolutions covering various matters. We now respectfully submit Resolution No. 4 for your kind consideration, which relates to the Department of Telecommunications and Bharat Sanchar Nigam Limited and concerns the **"Implementation of the Hon'ble Supreme Court's judgment on TES Group 'B' seniority (Lists 1-17)"**, as detailed in the enclosed resolution, with a request to advise DoT and BSNL to resolve the issue expeditiously.

04. RESOLUTION NO. AIBSNLREA/AIC-VARNASI/04

IMPLEMENTATION OF SUPREME COURT JUDGMENT ON TES GROUP B SENIORITY (LISTS 1–17):

The All India Conference of AIBSNLREA, held at Varanasi on 24th and 25th March 2026 expresses deep concern that, despite the unequivocal judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 14.12.2017 in CA No. 4389 of 2010, accepting the Expert Committee's recommendations and directing revision of Seniority Lists 1 to 17 of TES Group B, holding of Review DPCs for DE promotions ordered by DoT prior to 01.10.2000 and extending the consequential benefits remain unimplemented. The Conference records with dismay that DoT and BSNL continue to shift responsibility, with DoT stating that all files were handed over to BSNL, and BSNL insisting that action requires DoT's approval, which has resulted in an unacceptable administrative stalemate for over seven years. **This Conference urges the Department of Telecommunications and BSNL to immediately initiate and complete Review DPCs for all DE promotions ordered prior to 01.10.2000**, based on the revised Seniority Lists 1–17 issued on 04.06.2019, and to extend all consequential benefits including refixation of pensionary benefits.
