
Grievance Description

This grievance is to be redressed by CGHS Directorate. It is requested to advise AD CGHS Lucknow to withdraw the instruction requiring three quotations for approving tests not included in CGHS rate list, which has caused considerable anguish among the pensioner beneficiaries, many of whom are already grappling with health challenges. The expectation that senior citizens—often with limited mobility and cognitive strain, should physically or virtually solicit multiple quotations from diagnostic centers is not only impractical but also insensitive to their condition.
