The concerned Addl. Directors had been directed to visit these cities and ascertain the feasibility, provide data regarding the likely number of beneficiaries and availability of suitable accommodation etc.</p> <p>2. The employees and pensioners in this location are eagerly waiting with the hope that, based on the data provided, the process of hiring accommodation and other formalities would have already started.</p> <p>3. We would therefore request you to kindly ensure that the process is completed early, making the dream of these employees and pensioners comes true.</p>

<p>The opening of new Wellness Centres involves creation of new posts of staff like Medical Officers, Pharmacists, Nursing Officers, Junior Health Administrative Assistants, etc. and has financial implications. For creation of these posts, approval of Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance and Department of Personnel & Training is required.</p> <p>2. Even with creation of minimum number of posts of staff, the financial implications would involve a recurring expenditure of Rs.4.80 crore per year and a one-time non-recurring expenditure of Rs.0.75 crore to Rs.1.00 crore for which the approval of Department of Expenditure, Ministry of Finance is required. Therefore, the Ministry takes a considered view for opening of CGHS Wellness Centres at new places at an appropriate time.</p> <p>3. Meanwhile, Central Government pensioners residing in Non-CGHS covered areas have the option to avail CGHS facilities from nearby CGHS covered cities. Also, the Central Government serving employees residing in areas not covered by CGHS are covered under another Health Scheme viz. Central Services (Medical Attendance), Rules, 1944.</p>
