

Ques : But CDA calculation shown in excel sheet attached to your write up (dated 16-04-2010) appear to be not in accordance with DoP order. As per the said order for an existing pension of Rs.1000/- the revised pension works out to be Rs. 2260/- (Pension Rs.1000/- Dearness Pension Rs.500/- Balance old DA Rs.360/- Total Rs. 1860/- Fitment weightage 40 % of Rs.1000 i.e., 400/- Total revised pension Rs.2260/) This is more than IDA formula i.e Basic Pension+IDADA @ 68.8%+ weightage @30% of both - Krishna Deshpande CAO (Retd)

Ans : The DoP order referred to by you is applicable to past Central Govt. pensioners retired prior to 01.01.2006 and who were in receipt of CDA pension and CDA DA of 74 % (including 50 % DA merger) as on 01.01.2006. Our calculation sheet is in respect of the past BSNL pensioners retired prior to 01.01.2007 who were in receipt of 68.8 % IDA DA. The DA merger benefit is not given in pay revision for serving BSNL employees. The CDA calculation sheet shows what a past pensioner of BSNL retired prior to 01.1.2007 would be getting if the CDA formula of 40 % fitment benefit to basic pension is given. This works out to Rs. 2088/- only and is far below Rs. 2194/- which a BSNL Pensioner may get by applying the same fitment benefit as given to the serving employees of BSNL You may well know that whatever may be the fitment method for revision of pension, BSNL Pensioners will get fitment benefit applied only on what they actually received on 01.01.2007 on IDA DA and not on 86 % of CDA DA which they never received.
